- ✓ Explore hands-on tools to use with children and adults to help them integrate primitive motor patterns that are interfering with emotional development.



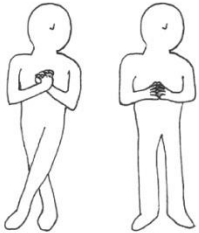
